Yvette motions to adjourn – Betty seconds – all in favor

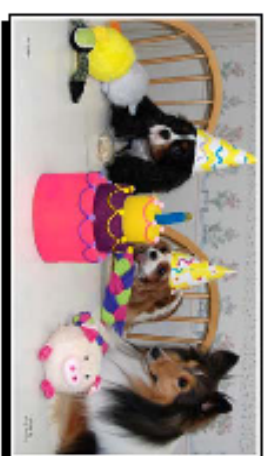
