Driving Directions to 20 Aug Meeting

From the North:

Merge onto I-270 West towards Hilliard/Dayton. Take the Roberts Road Exit (#10). Turn left onto Roberts Road/CR 28. At the Intersection of Roberts and Dublin Road, turn left.

From the South:

Merge onto I-270 West towards Indianapolis. Take the Roberts Road Exit #10. Turn right onto Roberts Road/CR 28.

From the East:

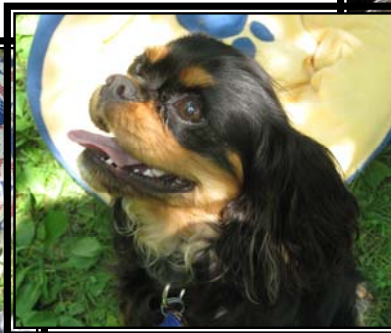
Take I-70 West to I-270 North. Take the Roberts Road Exit #10. Turn right onto Roberts Road/CR 28. At the Intersection of Roberts and Dublin Road, turn left.

From the West:

Take Roberts Road East until it dead ends into Dublin Road. At the Intersection of Roberts and Dublin Road, turn left.

For all directions: Follow Dublin Road North until it ends at the traffic light. Next, turn left at the light onto Scioto Darby Creek Road. Cross over the railroad tracks and turn right onto the first street which is Scioto-Darby Executive Court. Follow Scioto-Darby Executive Court to the Humane Society building on the left.

What is a MACH Title?

The most treasured AKC Agility title is the Master Agility Champion title, or "MACH". It is the hardest, most coveted, and rewarding title to achieve.

In order to achieve the MACH title, one must earn 20 Double Q's and 750 points. The MACH dog must exhibit superior performance on the agility course.

Each day of the dog show there is a chance to earn a Double Q. In order to earn one, the handler and the dog must run both the Jumpers and the Standard courses perfectly.

Then comes the earning of the 750 points. Each agility course has a standard course time. Besides accuracy, one must also be efficient. Points are calculated by how many seconds under the time the dog runs the course. For a 38 second course, a finish time of 30 earns 8 points.

A MACH ribbon is very large and many times handlers grab the last jump bar as part of the trophy.
